Born on February 23, 1935 at Carroll, Iowa, Agnes was the daughter of John and Elizabeth (Leiting) Sanders. She attended school at St. Francis of Assisi in Maple River, before graduating from St. Angela's Academy in Carroll.

On November 22, 1955 Agnes was united in marriage to Louis Halbur at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church in Maple River. The couple made their home south of Halbur, where they were active in grain and livestock farming. Agnes was a devoted wife, mother, and homemaker. She was known for her fabulous cooking, sharp card playing, and being an avid gardener. She and Louis enjoyed traveling together, and attending their grandchildren's sporting events. The couple retired to their home in Halbur in August of 2006. Agnes will be remembered for her deep devotion to her faith, and family.
