Albert Nagl, 95 of Carroll, died Sunday, November 13, 2011 at the Carroll Health Center Nursing Home in Carroll.

Peter and Paul School, later graduating from Carroll High School in 1935. On November 4, 1942 he married Cecilia Miller at St. Anthony Hospital Chapel in Carroll. Abe worked for the United States Postal Service for 30 years as a mail carrier. In retirement he enjoyed spending time with family, walking to daily mass, sitting on his front porch, and watching the stock market. Abe was a member of Holy Spirit Church in Carroll.
