March 21, 1924 - December 5, 2015

Al Dentlinger, 91 of Westside, died Saturday, December 5, 2015 at the Denison Care Center in Denison, Iowa.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, December 9, 2015 at St. John's Catholic Church in Arcadia. The Celebrant will be Fr. Gary Snyder. Con-Celebrant will be Fr. Born on March 21, 1924 at Arcadia, Iowa, Aloysius "Al" was the son of Joseph and Anna (Hoelscher) Dentlinger. Al attended St. John School and later served in the United States Marines. Following his honorable discharge he returned to the Arcadia area where he was employed with the Collison family as a farmhand.

On January 28, 1947, Al was united in marriage to Isabelle Lampe at St. John's Catholic Church in Arcadia. Following their marriage Al and Izzie made their home south of Westside where he was engaged as a grain and livestock farmer. In 1987 following their retirement they moved into Westside. Al and Izzie enjoyed attending dances and card clubs. In his spare time Al also enjoyed fishing, bowling and spending time with his family.

Al was a member of St. John's Church, Carroll Knights of Columbus, and the Arcadia American Legion.

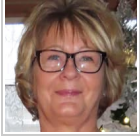
