Amie Schroeder Neal, age 55, of Atlanta, Georgia passed away peacefully at her home on September 3, 2025, after a four-year courageous battle with cancer.

A gravesite Celebration of Life will be held at 1:00 P.M. on Saturday, October 11, 2025, at Mt. Olivet Cemetery in Carroll, Iowa, with Father Craig Collison presiding. Amie was born on September 26, 1969, in Carroll to David (Barney) and Linda Schroeder. She joined an older sister, Suzanne, and siblings Jessica and David (Alex) were added to the family later. Amie graduated from Kuemper Catholic Schools and went on to receive a degree from Iowa State University.
