Ann Heires, age 87, of Carroll, Iowa, died Thursday evening October 30, 2008, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll. Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 A.M., Tuesday, November 4, 2008, at Holy Spirit Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Father Timothy Johnson. On February 27, 1946, she was married to Herman L. Heires at St. Bernard Church in Breda. The couple farmed near Breda and in 1947 moved to their farm northwest of Guthrie Center. They retired in 1977 and moved to their home in Carroll. For twenty-two years Mr. and Mrs. Heires spent their summers at Cass Lake, Minnesota, and the winters in Carroll. She also worked part time at the K.C. Hall in Carroll for many years. She was a

member of Holy Spirit Parish, Parish Ladies Guild, R.S.V.P., and St. Anthony Hospital Auxiliary.
