Mr. Neppel was born on January 22, 1918, at Willey, Iowa, the son of Maximillian and Rose (Werner) Neppel. He spent his younger years in the Willey community and attended country school and St. Mary School. On June 20, 1950, he was married to Helen M. Lutwitze at Sacred Heart Church in

Templeton with Father Otto Dentlinger officiating. The couple farmed in the Carroll, Lidderdale, and Roselle communities until 1978 when they moved to Carroll. In addition to farming Mr. Neppel was employed as a field man for the ASCS Office in Carroll and in later years by Farm Service of Roselle. He was a member of St. Lawrence Parish, Carroll County Farm Bureau, Honorary Life Member of the Knights of Columbus, and volunteered at the same day surgery waiting room at St. Anthony Regional Hospital. Arby enjoyed his family, playing cards, and walking.
