Arnold "Arnie" Tiefenthaler, 75 of Breda, died early Wednesday morning, October 8, 2025, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines, Iowa. Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 11, 2025, at St. Bernard's Church in Breda. Arnold "Arnie," son of Paul and Mary Tiefenthaler, was born on July 30, 1950, in Sac City, Iowa. He attended St. Bernard's Catholic School, graduating with the class of 1968. Arnie then attended mechanic school in Omaha, Nebraska. In 1969, Arnie enlisted with the U.S. Army Reserves and completed training at Fort Sill, Oklahoma. He was honorably discharged in 1975. Arnie worked with Bliss Tire Service in Carroll until 1972 when he started a 50-year career with Delmar Bruning and Bruning Oil, retiring in 2022.

Arnie dedicated his life to family and friends. He enjoyed family get-togethers and time with friends, having laughs, eating (of course), golfing, playing cards and other games at Reds and the golf course. Arnie was a dedicated 40-plus year member of the Breda Fire Department and Breda EMS, as well as, a 50 year member of the Breda American Legion, where he was still active until the day he passed away. 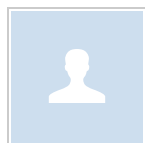
