March 2, 1922 - May 20, 2014

Arnold Golwitzer, 92 of Carroll, died early Tuesday morning May 20, 2014 at the Carroll Health Center Nursing Home in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, May 22, 2014, at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Schott. Music will be by Marcy Anderson and the St. Lawrence Choir with Sherry Loughran as cantor. Lector will be Vernon Drees. Born on March 2, 1922, at Dedham, Iowa, Arnold was the son of John and Clara (Heman) Golwitzer. He spent his younger years in the Dedham area and attended St. Joseph's School and then began farming. On September 7, 1943 he was united in marriage to Marcella Brincks at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Willey. The couple farmed near Willey until 1951 when they moved to the Lidderdale area where they farmed until 1985 and then retired to the Carroll Community. Arnold enjoyed sharing and spending time with mom "Sally". Arnie and Sally enjoyed going dancing with their good friends Vernon and Phyllis Drees. Arnold had a strong devotion to his faith as a member of the Carroll Knights of Columbus, former member of Holy Family Parish in Lidderdale, and a member of St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll.
