



## Bette Snyder

August 7, 1939 - May 30, 2015

Bette Snyder, 75 of Carroll, died early Saturday morning, May 30, 2015 at her home in Carroll surrounded by her family, following a brief illness.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Tuesday, June 2, 2015 at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Schott. Music for the mass will be by Kate Cuddy, St. Lawrence Choir with Sherry Loughran as cantor. Lectors for the funeral mass will be Bette's son, Randy Snyder; and Bette's grandchildren: Rease Snyder, Josh Snyder, Megan Snyder, Emerald Siepker, and Riley Snyder. Gift Bearers will be Bette's grandchildren: Lane Snyder, Jena Snyder, and Claire Snyder. Eucharistic Ministers will be Phil and Michele Phillips and Bette's daughter-in-law, Lori Snyder. Born on August 7, 1939 at Carroll, Iowa, the eldest of ten children, Bette was the daughter of Lawrence and Josephine (Loew) Siepker. She attended Sts. Peter and Paul School, St. Angela Academy, and later graduated from Kuemper Catholic High School with the Class of 1957.

On August 30, 1958, Bette was married to Roger "Rocker" Snyder. To this union were seven wonderful children. In 1983, Bette moved to the Carroll community where she held several jobs including working at New Hope Village for twelve years. Bette later did in home care for the elderly, most recently being employed with Caring Hands, a job she thoroughly loved and enjoyed.

In her spare time she enjoyed crocheting, cross stitching, and putting puzzles together. Bette loved her entire family and especially enjoyed being a mom, grandmother, and great-grandmother. Her favorite holiday was Christmas and loved listening and singing holiday songs.

Bette was a member of St. Lawrence Parish, Parish Ladies Guild, St. Anthony Hospital Auxiliary and St. Anthony Hospice.
