Bonnie Hein, 89 of Carroll, died peacefully, early Monday morning, June 12, 2023, at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

She spent her younger years in Templeton, graduating in 1941 from Sacred Heart School. Bonnie furthered her education at St. Mary's College in Omaha where she earned a degree in education. She taught school for 2 years and then was

united in marriage to Jerry Hein on August 29, 1955 in Omaha, Nebraska. Jerry's career with General Motors took the couple to Denver, Colorado; Dallas, Texas; Los Angeles, California; Franklin Lakes, New Jersey; and Dayton, Ohio. In 1992, the couple moved back to Carroll. Jerry passed away in 1995.

Bonnie was a member of Holy Spirit Church. She enjoyed golfing, needlepoint, gardening, reading, cooking, and spending time with her family.
