Brian Nieland, 63 of Breda, died unexpectedly on Tuesday, February 4, 2025 at Mountain Vista Medical Center in Mesa, Arizona.

love of baseball started at a young age and in high school he was on the Breda Bobcats championship team.

On July 24, 1981, Brian was united in marriage with Denise Pudenz at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church in Mount Carmel with Reverend Robert McClintock and Reverend LeRoy Suentjens officiating.

Brian was a very loving and caring husband, dad and grandpa. He thoroughly enjoyed spending time with his family and really treasured being a grandpa. He loved special times like teaching Aisha and Will at harvest time how to drive the tractor and “catch” loads with the auger wagon even though he’d say that the buddy seat in the tractor wasn’t any too big!

He was a farmer at heart and really enjoyed checking crops in his old Chevy truck. Brian raised pigs and cattle and developed great relationships with cattle buyers and truckers. After he retired in 2020, he also enjoyed helping Aaron and Alyce with anything they needed help with. The family was the center of his world. Brian also enjoyed his trips and times in Arizona. He enjoyed watching his grandkid’s softball and baseball games, hashing over the next morning in the shop how things could have went better.
