December 9, 1946 - October 19, 2022

Carol Kitt, 75 of Dedham, died Wednesday, October 19, 2022, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll surrounded by her family.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m., Saturday, October 22, 2022, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Dedham. The Celebrant will be Fr. She made many quilts with her mother and continued to after her mother's passing. Carol also was a gifted knitter and crocheter, passing this talent on to her granddaughters.
