Carol Roetker, 56 of Carroll, died Monday, April 25, 2016 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll from injuries received in an automobile accident north of Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday, April 30, 2016 at Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Johnson. Music will be by Barb McDermott and the Holy Spirit Choir with John Wagner as soloist. Lectors for the funeral mass will be Rose Miller and Dr. Alan Roetker. Born on April 13, 1960 at Carroll, Iowa, Carol was the daughter of Clair and Joan (Hamers) Roetker. Carol attended Holy Spirit School and later graduated from Kuemper Catholic High School with the Class of 1978. She furthered her education at DMACC in Carroll. For most of her working career she was employed at Pella Corporation.

Carol enjoyed swimming and was an avid Iowa State Cyclones fan; a season ticket holder to several of the men's and women's sports. She was an active member of Holy Spirit Parish in various capacities and was also involved with Christ Renews His Parish prayer group.
