



## Cecilia Bueltel

July 9, 1917 - May 14, 2011

Cecilia Bueltel, age 93 of Carroll, died Saturday, May 14, 2011 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m., Saturday, May 21, 2011 at St. Lawrence Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Schott. Christian Symbols will be placed by Cecilia's children. Pianist will be Marcy Anderson. Music will be by Justin and Tyler Badding and the St. Lawrence Choir. Born on July 9, 1917 at Templeton, Iowa, Cecilia was the daughter of J. Anton and Mary (Wiskus) Soppe. She attended country schools and following her formal education she helped her family at home on the farm. On January 18, 1944 she married Bernard Bueltel at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Carroll. They farmed near Halbur, raising seven children. They were members of St

Augustine's Parish in Halbur until 1975. Following Bernard's death, Cecilia moved to Carroll. Cecilia was a cook at Tony's restaurant in Carroll for 35 years, retiring at the age of 84. In retirement she enjoyed traveling to visit her children, and talking for hours on the phone with them. She enjoyed playing cards with her family and friends, crocheting, embroidery, making quilts for her family, feeding and watching her birds and tending to her flower garden. Cecilia's greatest love was for her family, especially her grandchildren and her great-grandchildren. She loved hosting her family gatherings and cooking for everyone. She was a member of St. Lawrence Parish, Parish Ladies Guild, and the Carroll Catholic Daughters of Americas.
