Cecilia Vonnahme, age 95, of Mt. Carmel, died Saturday, June 4, 2016 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll surrounded by her family.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, June 8, 2016 at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Catholic Church in Mt. Carmel. The celebrant will be Fr. Gary Snyder. Born on May 4, 1921 at Baileyville, Kansas, Cecilia was the daughter of Anton and Mary (Meyer) Kokenge. After she was born, her family moved back to Maple River, Iowa. It was here she spent her childhood, and attended St. Francis School. On February 28, 1948 Cecilia was united in marriage to Carl Vonnahme at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church in Maple River. The couple lived in several homes around the area, until settling in Mt. Carmel.

Cecilia enjoyed keeping busy. She was a devoted homemaker, served as a cook at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel School, and worked in housekeeping at the Carroll Manor. After retirement Cecilia worked part time at Mallard View, and volunteered at New Hope Village in Carroll. She enjoyed gardening, canning, cooking, and baking. She was known for her homemade noodles, cinnamon rolls, buns, and apple pies. Most of all Cecilia enjoyed her loving family, and the gatherings they shared on countless Sunday afternoons. Cecilia was a member of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish, and ladies guild, as well as a forty-four year member of the Breda American Legion Auxiliary.

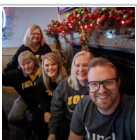
