



## Chad Wittrock

February 7, 1974 - September 23, 2010

Chad Wittrock, age 36, of Carroll, Iowa, died, Thursday, September 23, 2010, at his home, following a courageous battle with cancer.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated 10:30 a.m., Monday, September 27, 2010 at Holy Spirit Church in Carroll. The celebrant will be Father Timothy Johnson. Chad was born on February 7, 1974, in Carroll, Iowa, the son of Earl and Vernell (Bueltel) Wittrock. He spent his lifetime in the Carroll Community and attended Holy Spirit School and Kuemper High School, graduating with the Class of 1992. In 1994 Chad started All Pro Garage Door Company and was operating till present day. Chad married Carrie Heim on November 4, 1995 at St. Lawrence Church in Carroll, Iowa. The couple made their home Southwest

of Carroll. Chad enjoyed boating, fishing, hunting, repairing and fixing cars, and most of all the time spent with his family. He was a member of Holy Spirit Church in Carroll.
