Chris Urszan, 67 of Glidden, died early Friday morning, August 10, 2012 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

retired from the Navy in June of 1988 and held several jobs in the San Diego area. Chris then returned to the Carroll area. He loved the outdoors, and held a special regard for dogs. He raised Doberman Pinschers and in 2002 adopted a Rottweiler named Duchess. In July of 2010 he was united in marriage to Sandy Heires. Chris loved spending time with his wife Sandy and many friends and family. Most recently he was working for the Graphic Edge in Carroll, providing transportation for the prisoners in Rockwell City.
