Clifford Hugeback, 81 of Carroll, died Saturday, August 20, 2011 at Regency Park Nursing Home in Carroll.

He grew up and attended school in the Maple River area. On June 27, 1951 he married Shirley Sprimont in Nebraska. Clifford served in the United States Army from 1954 – 1959 and

upon being honorable discharged the couple settled in Wright County near Clarion, Iowa. In 1961 Clifford and Shirley returned to the Carroll area and moved to the family farm west of Carroll. Clifford farmed and also worked at Farmland for over 35 years, retiring in 1991. Upon retirement Clifford and Shirley moved to Carroll. Over the years they were foster parents for several children. He enjoyed having his morning coffee with his friends, gardening, his dog Bubbles, and farming. Clifford was a member of Holy Spirit Parish, Carroll Knights of Columbus, and the Carroll American Legion, Maurice Dunn Post # 7.
