Crescentia Luchtel, age 94, of Carroll, Iowa, died Thursday, May 13, 2010, at the Carroll Health Center Nursing Home in Carroll. She graduated from St. Bernard High School in Breda in 1933 and was member of the St. Bernard High School Symphony Orchestra. Crescentia and Richard H. Luchtel were united in marriage on June 27, 1939, at St. Bernard Church in Breda with Msgr. Frank Greteman officiating. The couple lived in Des Moines for three years and then moved to

Templeton where they resided for several years, and moved to Carroll in 1954. Crescentia and Richard traveled through 46 states, Mexico, and Canada, and for twenty-four years spent six months each year at their winter home in Mercedes, Texas. She was a fifty year member of the Catholic Daughters of America. Crescentia enjoyed traveling, music, playing cards, and dancing.
