January 26, 1958 - December 31, 2011

Dean Patrick Mitchell, age 53, of Carroll, Iowa, died Saturday, December 31, 2011, at his residence of an apparent heart condition.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 11 A.M., Wednesday, January 4, 2012, at Holy Spirit Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Father Timothy Boekelman. Burial will be at Mt. He graduated from Carroll High School with the Class of 1976. From 1977 to 1989 Dean made his home in Coon Rapids where he was employed by the Garst and Thomas Seed Company. He then returned to Carroll to make his home and was employed for a short time by the Carroll Today Newspaper. Dean was a member of Holy Spirit Parish, and enjoyed gardening, fishing, and watching sports on television.
