Delores Wiehn, age 92, of Carroll died unexpectedly on Monday, March 30, 2020.

Delores, the daughter of John and Elizabeth (Von Bonn) Turner was born on March 18, 1928 on a farm near Elgin, Nebraska. She attended St. John Berchman's School in Raeville. After her formal education she assisted in taking care of her many nieces, and nephews, as well as assisting with her family grain and livestock operation.

In 1951 Delores met the love of her life at a dance in Raeville. On August 26, 1952 Delores was united in marriage to Daniel Wiehn at St. Bonaventure's Catholic Church in Raeville. The couple moved to Dedham in 1954, later living on several acreages in the Carroll Area. In addition to being a devoted homemaker, Delores worked at the Red Carpet Restaurant, and later as a caregiver to her mother.

Delores enjoyed embroidery, scrapbooking, genealogy, gardening, and tending to her flowers, watching her soap operas, and rooting for the Chicago Cubs. Most of all she enjoyed her grandchildren and great-grandchildren never missing an event they were in. Delores had a deep devotion to her faith praying countless rosaries over the years in addition to being an active parishioner of St. John Paul II Parish- St. Lawrence Church.
