Donald Miller, age 87, of Dedham, died Saturday, May 25, 2024 at his home in Dedham.

Donald was active in the American Legion serving as a past Dedham American Legion Commander, Carroll County Adjutant, Carroll County Chaplain, current Dedham Legion Chaplain and was serving on the Dedham Legion Honor Guard. In 2023, he was selected and went on the Honor Flight to Washington, D.C. Donald was an avid Chicago Cubs fan and enjoyed collecting memorabilia.
