She spent her time picking up lots of rocks in the fields and kept some for her projects. Dorothy sewed blue jean quilts, "crazy" quilts as she would call them and also enjoyed word find books, coloring, grinding horseradish, playing cards with the Dedham ladies and most of all spending time with her family. Dorothy always loved Heritage Bank Trips. She was a member of St. Joseph's Parish, Parish Ladies Guild, Catholic Daughters of Americas, Dedham American Legion Auxiliary, and RSVP Singers.
