Dorothy Kluver, age 94, of Carroll, died Sunday, January 15, 2023 at Accura Healthcare in Carroll.

In 1967 they relocated to Carroll. In addition to being a devoted homemaker, Dorothy cleaned many homes in the area for over 46 years. Dorothy enjoyed playing bingo, cards, and dancing at many area dances. Dorothy was a member of St. John Paul II Parish in Carroll.
