Eileen "Leenie" Beyerink, 67 of Maple River, died Tuesday, January 24, 2012 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be at 10 a.m. Saturday at Holy Spirit Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Johnson. Born on August 27, 1944 at Carroll, Iowa, Eileen Ann was the daughter of Joseph and Velma (Niehaus) Schroeder. She spent her younger years in the

Arcadia Community and attended St. John School, later graduating from Kuemper High School in 1962. Following her formal education Leenie attended the Iowa School of Beauty and began working for Hannasch Beauty Shop. On April 23, 1966 she married Leonard Beyerink Jr. at St. John Catholic Church in Arcadia. In 1968, following the death of Leonard's father, Junior and Leenie assumed ownership of Little Gus's in Maple River. Leenie's husband passed away in 1994 and she continued to own and operate the business. Leenie dearly loved her family, especially her grandchildren and always put the needs of others before her own. She also enjoyed reading, country music and socializing with the many patrons at Little Gus's. She was a member of the Arcadia American Legion Auxiliary, lifelong member of St. Francis Church where she was active in the many church functions, and was currently a member of Holy Spirit Parish in Carroll.

Survivors include two daughters: Jodi Wieland and her husband Kevin of Templeton, and Jackie Rahe and her husband Dean of Bancroft; four grandchildren: Dylan, Carter, and Jake Wieland, and Marissa Rahe; two sisters: Karen (Kenny) Baumhover of Maple River, and LuAnn (Gary) Reicks of Lake City; her brother-in-law, Gary Beyerink of Maple River; her sister-in-law, Carol (Steve) Macke of Faribault, MN; as well as many nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, cousins, and many friends.
