Joseph School in Dedham and graduated from Carroll High School in 1951. On June 2, 1953, Eugene was united in marriage with Carol H. Klocke at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Dedham by Father Henry Pick. To this union three children were born. The couple lived on the now century farm north of Dedham until retiring in 1994 and moving into Carroll.

Eugene and Carol operated a successful farrow to finish hog operation. Eugene served on the Dedham Coop Board for several years. He enjoyed farming, daily coffee with the farmers in Dedham, going to casinos, and playing many card games after retirement with friends and family. Eugene and Carol made biannual trips to Las Vegas every March and November for many years. Their last trip was in 2024.
