Eugene R. Snyder, 73 of Carroll, died Thursday, February 23, 2017 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

A funeral mass will be held at 11 a.m. Monday, February 27, 2017 at Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Johnson. Music will be by Barb McDermott and the Holy Spirit Choir. Lector for the funeral mass will be Russ Snyder. Gift Bearers will be Elvira Kitt and Snort Snyder. Eucharistic Minister will be Julie McClintock. Burial will be at 1:30 p.m. Monday in St. Mary's Cemetery in Auburn.

Born on April 19, 1943 at Lake City, Iowa, Eugene was the son of Edward and Mary (Vonnahme) Snyder. He attended country school in Sac County, Auburn High School, and later graduated from St. Bernard's High School in 1961.

Eugene then attended Ray Vogue Fashion School in Chicago. Following his schooling he was employed in fashion design for Noriko Fashion and then Hino and Malee Fashion Design until his retirement. Eugene truly had a

passion for clothing design and sewing various types of clothing. In 2009, Eugene returned to the Carroll area.
