Eunice Stark, 86 of Breda, died peacefully, Saturday, April 21, 2012 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, April 25, 2012 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Fr. Lynn Bruch. Born on July 16, 1925 at Templeton, Iowa, Eunice M. was the daughter of Fred and Cecelia (Friedman) Stueve. Eunice spent her early childhood years

in the Templeton Community and later attended St. Joseph's School in Dedham. On July 22, 1944 she was married to Willard Stark at St. Ambrose Cathedral in Des Moines by Fr. Gerald Deere. Following her husband's military service they returned to the Breda area. Throughout her lifetime Eunice was active within the parish as a lay distributor, Parish Ladies Guild, and also made embroidered baptismal gowns for the new babies that were baptized in the parish. She helped organize and participated in the monthly Bingo at the Carroll Health Center. Eunice loved gardening, cooking, and baking and passed many of her recipes down to her family. She enjoyed her many friends and was active in several card clubs with them. Eunice was dedicated to her faith and her family and was very proud of her entire family. She was a member of St. Bernard's Parish, Parish Ladies Guild, National Catholic Order of Foresters, and the Breda American Legion Auxiliary. Survivors include her son Gary Stark and his wife Carol of Carroll; three granddaughters: Tami (Kevin) Lux of Cedar Rapids, Tara (Mark) Thomsen of Carroll, and Tasha (Ron) Badding of Carroll; 10 great-grandchildren: Nate, Gabe and Jack Lux; Kennedy, Karsyn and Kora Thomsen; and Parker, Mallory, Sophie, and Brock Badding; one sister, Norma Jean Kofmehl of Holstein; one sister-in-law, Ruth Ann Stark of Breda; as well as many nieces, nephews, and many friends.

Eunice was preceded in death by her parents; husband Willard in December of 1987; and her brother, Eugene Stueve.
