Florence Bruening, age 98, of Carroll, died Monday, May 20, 2019, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Florence, the daughter of George and Mary (Goetzinger) Masching was born on January 29, 1921 at Carroll, Iowa. Florence grew up near Roselle, and attended school at Holy Angels School in Roselle. While growing up Florence helped her parents operate their dairy.

On October 3, 1945, Florence was united in marriage to Norbert Bruening at Holy Angels Catholic Church in Roselle. The couple made their home in the Mt. Carmel area, where they were active in grain and livestock farming. Florence enjoyed fishing, playing cards, quilting, sewing, and attending many dances with her husband Norb. She was a former member of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish, Choir, and Ladies Guild, current parishioner of St. John Paul II Parish, Legion of Mary, Breda American Legion Auxiliary, and the Catholic Daughters of the Americas.
