Florence Schroer, age 92, of Carroll, Iowa, died early Monday, May 3, 2010, at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Following her education she helped on the family farm and did domestic work for families in the area. On January 31, 1939, she was married to Anthony L. Schroer at St. Augustine Church in Halbur. The couple farmed in the Guthrie Center, Halbur, and Templeton area until 1953 when they moved to their farm

north of Manilla. In December 1979 they moved to their home in Carroll. Florence was a homemaker. She was a member of St. Lawrence Parish and Parish Ladies Guild. Florence enjoyed her family, quilting, and gardening. Survivors include her son, Robert Schroer and wife Theresa of Carroll; her daughters, Marilyn Porter and husband Don of Sioux Falls, South Dakota, JoAnn Mell and husband Paul of Norway, Linda Prussing and husband Roger of Ida Grove, and Donna Williams and husband Bruce of Villisca; twenty-two grandchildren; eighteen great grandchildren; one great great grandson; a sister, Phyllis Riesberg of Carroll; and sisters-in-law, Edna Mae Trecker of Halbur, Mary Trecker of Carroll, and Margie Schroer of Owatonna, Minnesota.
