Gene Neppl, age 63, of Halbur, died Tuesday, July 23, 2019 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Friday, July 26, 2019 at St. Augustine Catholic Church in Halbur. The Celebrant will be Fr. Tim Friedrichsen. Gene was united in marriage to Joanne Bullmann on August 13, 1988 at St. Augustine Catholic Church in Halbur. The couple made their home in Halbur, and Gene worked at various jobs around the area. Gene enjoyed watching the University of Iowa Hawkeyes, Nascar, Bowling, Golfing, camping, riding his motorcycle, and assisting with the Halbur Celebration. Gene was a member of the Halbur City Council, the Halbur Fire Department, Halbur U., Western Iowa Cycle Riders, Knights of Columbus, and St. Augustine Parish.

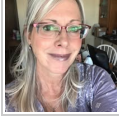
