Georgia Ellerbrock, 84, of Carroll, died Monday, January 20, 2014 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

She graduated from 8th Grade at St. Monica's in Mishawaka, Indiana, and attended two years at Mishawaka High School. The family then moved to Lake City, in 1945 where she graduated from Lake City High School with the Class of 1947. On Thanksgiving Day, November 23, 1950 she was united in marriage to Edwin Ellerbrock at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Lake City. Georgia lived on Edwin's family century farm for 36 years where they raised their three children. She moved to Carroll after the death of Edwin.

Georgia was a devoted wife and mother, and also worked at Continental Telephone Company in Lake City. She was active in several card clubs and also enjoyed embroidery, paint by numbers, bingo, reading, and word searches. Georgia also had a deep devotion to her faith being active with St. Mary's Parish in Auburn, former Legion Auxiliary member, and St. Mary's Rosary Society. Currently Georgia was a member of St. Lawrence Parish in Carroll.
