Henry B. Snyder, age 91, of Carroll, Iowa, died early Friday, March 20, 2009, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll. Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 A.M., Monday, March 23, 2009, at Holy Spirit Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Father Timothy Johnson. The casket will be taken to the church at 8:30 A.M. Monday to lie in state until the time of the funeral mass. Lector will be Curt Snyder. The couple made their home in Carroll. Mr. Snyder had been employed for many years as a punch press operator at the Heider Manufacturing Company in Carroll and when the Heider plant closed Henry decided to retire. He was a member of Holy Spirit Parish. Henry enjoyed going to the Adoration Chapel, fishing, and boating.
