Hildegard Rupiper, age 99, of Templeton, Iowa, died Saturday, June 12, 2010, at the Carroll Health Center Nursing Home in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 A.M., Tuesday, June 15, 2010, at Sacred Heart Church in Templeton. The Celebrant will be Father Dale Reiff. The casket will be taken to the church at 8:30 A.M. Tuesday to lie in state until the time of the funeral mass. The Templeton Catholic Daughters of America will form an honor guard at the church for the funeral mass. Lector will be a granddaughter, Renee Langin. to Albert W. Rupiper at Sacred Heart Church in Templeton with Msgr. F.H. Huesmann officiating. The couple farmed north of Templeton until November 1976 when they moved to their home in Templeton. She was a member of Sacred Heart Parish, Parish Ladies Guild, and the Templeton Catholic Daughters of America. Hildegard enjoyed her family, playing cards, cooking, and gardening.
