Irma, the daughter of Joseph and Anna (Billmeier) Meier was born on March 28, 1931 on a farm near Roselle. A lifelong resident of Carroll County, Irma attended country school near Manning, and later earned her G.E.D. On October 19, 1950 Irma was united in marriage to Leonard Gehling at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Manning. The couple lived near Manning until 1963 when they moved to a farm south of Carroll until 1981. At that time they moved to their current home east of Carroll. Over the years Irma worked as a cook at Holy Spirit School, Nurse's Aide at St. Anthony Regional Hospital, J.C. Penny's, and Sernetts. She also offered childcare out of her home. Irma enjoyed embroidery, reading, cooking, and gardening. In retirement Irma volunteered for the Holy Spirit Ladies Guild.

Irma is survived by her children: Diane K. Beberniss of Carroll, Duane L. Gehling of Coon Rapids, and Doreen A. (Mike) Lappe of Carroll; 8 grandchildren; 19 great-grandchildren with 1 more expected soon.
