Isabelle Dentlinger, 99 years young, passed away peacefully Wednesday, November 27, 2024 at the Denison Care Center in Denison, Iowa.

On January 28, 1947, Izzie was united in marriage to Aloysious, "Al," at St. John's Catholic Church in Arcadia. Following their marriage, Al and Izzie made their home south of Westside where Izzie devoted the next years of her life to raising her four children. Following Al's retirement in 1987, they moved from the farm into town.

Al and Izzie enjoyed dances, card clubs, fishing, and spending time in Okoboji annually. They were able to travel and visit family in Illinois, Wisconsin, Colorado, and even went to Hawaii with Lawrence and Arlene for a vacation.
