James Brincks, age 76, of Carroll, died Tuesday, January 16, 2024 at Accura Healthcare of Carroll.

After his formal education Jim worked as a farm hand before working for Hallet Construction from 1966-1969. Jim then became an Owner-Operator Truck Driver, pulling for various companies until he began a 30-year career

with Smithway Motor Xpress. In 1987 Jim earned Owner-Operator of the Year Award, and in 2002 was awarded 1,500,000 miles of Safe Driving award. In his spare time he enjoyed hunting, playing cards, watching football, and the St. Louis Cardinals.
