Born on June 4, 1936 at Carroll, Iowa, James was the son of Frank and Mayme (Wiederin) Pudenz. Jim attended Our Lady of Mt. Carmel School and graduated in 1954. Jim served in the United States Army from 1955-1957 and following his honorable discharge returned to the Carroll area. Jim was united in marriage to Marilyn Masching on August 22, 1959 at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Carroll. To this union were 8 children. Jim and Mary made their home north of Carroll where he was a lifelong grain and livestock farmer. Mary passed away in 2011 and on March 2, 2013, Jim married Mary Ann (Boje) Boeckman at Holy Spirit Church in Carroll.

Family was most important to Jim; he loved going to his grandchildren's activities, and family events; especially the annual family trip to Lake Okoboji. Jim was an avid Iowa State Cyclone fan and St. Louis Cardinals fan. In his spare time, he enjoyed golfing and traveling with his family.


