They were married in St. John's Church in Arcadia by her uncle Reverend William Buckholz. Jean and Kenneth lived on a farm south of Carroll where they raised their 3 sons and 3 daughters. She was a dedicated homemaker. Jean enjoyed gardening, playing cards and going to dances.

In 1988 the couple moved into Carroll. Over the years Jean worked in the kitchen at Arcadia Legion Hall and Holy Spirit School cafeteria.
