Jeanette Venner, age 86, of Carroll, died Friday, April 3, 2015 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Born on February 23, 1929 at Carroll, Iowa, Jeanette was the daughter of Philip and Catherine (Eischeid) Dentlinger. She grew up near the Halbur community, where she attended St. Augustine School, and later attended St. Angela's Academy in Carroll. On May 26, 1948 Jeanette was united in marriage to Edward Venner at St. Augustine Catholic Church in Halbur. The couple made their home northeast of Manning, where both Edward and Jeanette were active in the farming operation. In addition to farming, Jeanette was a dedicated homemaker, and accomplished artist with oils and porcelain.

Jeanette enjoyed world travel with her family and friends. She traveled many times to the east coast to visit her daughters, and grandchildren. She also enjoyed landscaping, and her many flowers. Jeanette was a member of the St. Augustine Altar Guild, Catholic Daughters of the Americas, St. Anthony Hospital Auxiliary, the Manning General Hospital and Plaza Auxiliary, and Holy Spirit Parish.
