Jerry was born on May 28, 1926, at Halbur, Iowa, the son of Philip and Katherine (Eischeid) Dentlinger. He attended St. Augustine School. Jerry and Elaine Imming were married on August 16, 1948, at Saint Peter and Paul Church in Carroll with his uncle, Father Otto Dentlinger officiating. Jerry

farmed most of his life helping his dad on the family farm, then farming on his own and held various other jobs including the maintenance department at the Carroll Municipal Golf Course. In 1972 Jerry and Elaine bought an acreage east of Carroll where he farmed and raised feeder pigs. They sold the acreage in 1988 and moved to Carroll and in 2003 moved to Glidden. Jerry became a resident of Regency Park Nursing Home in 2006. Jerry enjoyed farming, traveling, golfing, playing cards, and his grandchildren and their activities. He was a member of Holy Spirit Parish in Carroll.
