Jerry Schroeder, 72 of Carroll, IA died Wednesday morning, April 23, 2014 at his home in Carroll.

Born on June 19, 1941 at Carroll, Iowa, Jerome was the son of Edmund and Helen (Wiederhold) Schroeder. He spent his entire lifetime in the Carroll Community and attended Kuemper Catholic Schools, graduating from Kuemper High School in 1959. Jerry worked at the Sharp Funeral Home in Carroll and later worked road construction where he met Sherry Luing; to this union were five children.

Jerry later married Charlotte Franklin on December 26, 1986 at Marne, Iowa. Jerry worked with his father with Schroeder's Glass and Awning and then entered into partnership with his brother Barney. 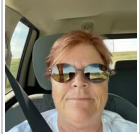
