Joan H. Schleisman, age 75, of Carroll, Iowa, died Wednesday, July 22, 2009, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll. Mrs. Schleisman was born on April 3, 1934, at Templeton, Iowa, the daughter of Edward and Anna (Wuebker) Hannasch. At a young age her family moved to Carroll where she attended Saint Peter and Paul Grade School and graduated from St. Angela Academy in 1952. Prior to her marriage she was employed as the Deputy County Auditor for Carroll County. On February 7, 1959, she was married to Dennis Schleisman at Saint Peter and Paul Church in Carroll with Father Adams officiating. The couple farmed

near Spring Valley, Minnesota until 1966 when they moved to their farm north of Lidderdale. In 1984 they moved to their home in Carroll. Mrs. Schleisman was a homemaker and in later years was employed as a secretary for the Carroll Country Club and Iowa Small Engine Center. She was a member of St. Lawrence Parish, Parish Ladies Guild, and St. Anthony Hospital Auxiliary. Mrs. Schleisman enjoyed her family, playing cards, playing golf, bowling, ceramics, and oil painting.
