Joleen Klocke, 83 of Carroll, died early Friday morning, January 27, 2023, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, February 1, 2023 at St. Lawrence Church – St. John Paul II Parish in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Kevin Richter. Visitation will begin on Tuesday at the Sharp Funeral Home in Carroll with a rosary at 4 p.m. by the Carroll Catholic Daughters of the Americas. Following the rosary visitation will continue until 7 p.m. Additional visitation will be from 9:30-10:15 a.m. on Wednesday at St. Lawrence Church.

Born on October 18, 1939, in Carroll, Iowa, Joleen was the daughter of John and Emilia (Neppl) Broich. She attended St. Mary's School in Willey, St. Angela Academy, and graduated from Kuemper Catholic High School in 1957.

Joleen then attended and graduated with the first class of the Antonian School of Nursing in 1959. On June 18, 1960, she was united in marriage to Ronald Klocke at St. Mary's Church in Willey. The couple farmed southeast of Dedham; Joleen worked for St. Anthony Hospital for many years, The Village Clinic in Coon Rapids, and retired in 2004 from St. Anthony Clinic in Coon Rapids.

She enjoyed playing cards with several card groups, reading, and trips to the casino.

Joleen volunteered in many capacities with St. Lawrence Guild, Catholic Daughters of the Americas, Homemakers Club, Birthday Club, Dedham American Legion Auxiliary, Antonian Alumni, Hospice Volunteer, and RSVP Volunteer.
