Kathleen Skalla, age 80, of Carroll, Iowa, died early Thursday morning, September 16, 2010 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Kuemper High School, until her retirement. Kathleen enjoyed knitting, crocheting, reading, crossword puzzles, watching the birds, and spending time with her family. She was a member of St. Lawrence Parish, and the Parish Ladies Guild.
