



## Kenneth Snyder

April 19, 1936 - February 10, 2014

Kenny Snyder, 77 of Breda, died early Monday morning, February 10, 2014 at the Carroll Health Center.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Friday, February 14, 2014 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Father Gary Snyder. Music will be by Marilyn Hundling and the St. Bernard's Choir. Lector for the funeral mass will be Myrna Snyder. Gift Bearers will be Clair Snyder and Julius "Juke" Snyder. Born on April 19, 1936 at Breda, Iowa, Kenneth was the son of Cyril and Anna (Grote) Snyder. He attended St. Bernard's Grade School and graduated from

St. Bernard's High School. On October 10, 1959 he was united in marriage with Janice Siepker at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Carroll, Iowa.

The couple made their home in Breda where Kenny worked at Boeckman Feeds, running the grinder/mixer for 15 years and later was employed at Agri-Enterprises where he managed the grain and feed operation until his retirement. Kenny loved the Breda Community; serving many years on the city council and serving as Mayor of Breda. He also enjoyed fishing, spending time at his cabin at Lake View, having coffee with his friends, and "supervising" the streets of Breda. His greatest joy was spending time with his family. Kenny was a member of St. Bernard's Church, and a former member of the Breda Fire Department.
