Lawrence attended St. Joseph's School in Dedham and then began helping his parents with their farm operation. On June 6, 1950, Lawrence was united in marriage to Beth Klocke at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Templeton, Iowa. Lawrence and Beth made their home on the Klocke family farm southwest of Dedham where Lawrence continued the family farm operation of grain and livestock. In 2003, Lawrence and Beth moved to the Carroll community.

He always enjoyed his morning coffee; had a great passion for farming and antique tractors. His greatest joy was his family. Lawrence was a member of St. Lawrence Church in Carroll and a member for many years at St. Joseph's Church in Dedham.
