July 12, 1926 - October 19, 2021

A son of Michael and Frances (Hoffman) Sibenaller, Lawrence was born on July 12, 1926 near Roselle and attended Holy Angels Grade School. He entered the Army in August 1945 and served as part of the 1st Infantry Regiment in Korea during World War II. He was honorably discharged in January 1947. He and Mary Ann Niehaus were married on November 10, 1953, at St. John the Baptist Church in Arcadia, Iowa. Lawrence loved his work on the family farm, raising cattle and hogs. He enjoyed playing cards, supporting his grandchildren's activities, and connecting with neighbors and friends throughout the community. He was a lifelong member of Holy Angels Parish until its closing.
