Leo Danner, age 83, of Dedham, Iowa, died Thursday, January 22, 2009, at the Thomas Rest Haven in Coon Rapids. Mr. Danner enjoyed his family, feeding Black Angus cattle, cattle buying trips to Ogallala, Nebraska, and his 20 series John Deere antique tractors.
