



LeRoy "Doc" Steinkamp

November 27, 1952 - December 9, 2018

Leroy "Doc" Steinkamp, 66 of Breda, died Sunday, December 9, 2018 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll following a brief battle with cancer.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 2 p.m., Wednesday, December 12, 2018 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Fr. Gary Snyder. Mass Server will be Doc's brother, Tom Steinkamp. Music for the funeral mass will be by Marilyn Hundling and the St. Bernard's Choir. Lecter and Eucharistic Minister will be Leonard Snyder. Born on November 27, 1952 at Carroll, Iowa, LeRoy "Doc" Steinkamp was the son of Leonard and Lynette (Schultes) Steinkamp. Doc spent his entire lifetime in the Breda community and graduated from St. Bernard's High School in 1970. Following his schooling he was employed at the Breda Veterinarian Clinic for 17 years and later went to work for Pella Corporation in Carroll. For the past 25 years Doc was employed at Toyne Inc. in Breda.

Doc coached slow pitch for the Breda Zekers, enjoyed golfing, and was an avid Iowa Hawkeye and Chicago Cubs fan. He enjoyed socializing with family and friends at Zeke's, Red's and the Breda Golf Course. Doc had an enthusiastic personality that truly was a joy to be around. He was a member of St. Bernard's Church in Breda.

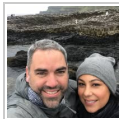

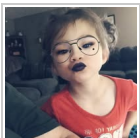
